Core uniques include all patients except those whose interaction with the facility is limited only to laboratory and telephone triage episodes of care.

The qualifying PCMHI encounter can occur anywhere in the administrative parent (health care system). The Veteran is always counted at their home site (where they are enrolled in primary care).
